

The DayTicket – All Important Information in a Nutshell!

Validity

Valid for one day (starting from the time of ticket validation until 3 a.m. on the following day).

Using the DayTicket

The DayTicket is either valid for one up to five adults and up to three children aged between 6 and 14 inclusive.

Additional charge for night lines

An additional charge must be paid for each person for the use of the BSAG night lines, the VWG NightExpress lines, and the „Nachtschwärmer“ (€ 1.00 per night and person or as a 4-trip ticket for € 3.60).

Area of validity

Valid on all modes of local public transport (buses, trams, and trains) in the VBN region within the price level of your purchased ticket.

Travelling with bicycles

Taking your bicycle with you is no problem at all on VBN buses, trams, and trains. In order to do so, you will need a bicycle ticket. This is available as a DayTicket for € 1.95 (price levels I, A, B and S) or for € 3.90 (for the entire VBN region).

Can the ticket be transferred?

Children aged up to and including 5 years old can travel in VBN public transport free of charge.

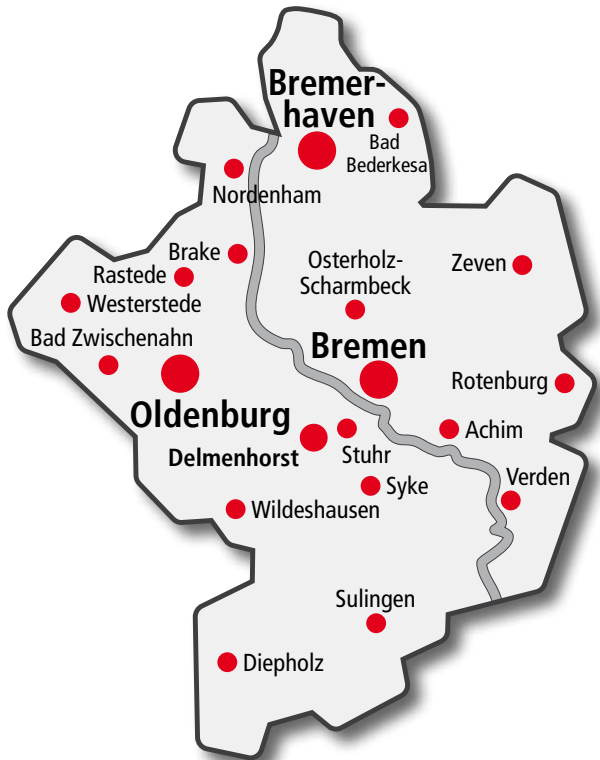

How to get your ticket.

Children aged up to and including 5 years old can travel in VBN public transport free of charge.

- You can purchase DayTickets
 - at the ticket offices and from the transport companies' customer service centres
 - in all buses from the bus personnel
 - from the ticket machines on board the BSAG trams
 - from other ticket machines, e.g. at the stations
- You receive your VBN ticket (e.g. DayTicket) with some clicks in your FahrPlaner app. Simply log in, book, and display your MobileTicket!
- Please note: on board of the DB Regio AG, Regio-S-Bahn, evb, erixx, NordWestBahn, and metronom trains, no VBN tickets are sold. You have to purchase these from the ticket machines before entering the train.
- If you are uncertain which price level is the right one for you, visit one of our customer centres, call us or find out more on the Internet at en.vbn.de. We'll be happy to help you!

Of course, virtually all buses and trains are pushchair and wheelchair accessible.

Remarks on the price regions

- Price level I (Bremen) = for travel in and between Bremen-Stadt (city area) and Bremen-Nord (North Bremen) no matter of the transport mode used.
- Price level A = the price for travelling within one community, e.g. Worpsswede. Price level B–H = the price is based on the number of zones travelled. (Price level B applies for 2 zones, for example when travelling from Zeven to Tarmstedt. Price level C applies for travelling within three zones. Price level H allows unlimited travel in the entire VBN region.)
- Price level S = for travel between Bremen and the surroundings of Lower Saxony, e.g. Bremen – Lilienthal or Bremen-Nord (North Bremen) – Schwanewede.
